The Shed is off the grid and lit with kerosene lamps, creating a warm and memorable atmosphere for a communal meal. The Shed Supper is not offered every night so be sure to check in with the Front Desk Team upon arrival and be sure to ask them to add your name.

WHAT TO WEAR

Fogo Island has seven distinct seasons coloured by a broad range of climatic conditions. Here, the weather is decidedly dynamic and can change in the blink of an eye. Our ever-evolving qualities of light, wind, and sea have captivated the hearts of locals and visitors alike for centuries. Besides being prepared to fall in love with Fogo Island, you should also be properly prepared to spend time outdoors.

Our weather can be sunny and warm one moment, and windy and penetrating the next. It is best to come prepared for anything the North Atlantic might throw at us, so we suggest that you pack clothing that can be layered with a waterproof, windproof jacket as an outer layer.

Fogo Island has remarkable hiking trails. Whether you are up for a short stroll, an amble, a tarry, a hike, or a backpacking trip, there is a trail for every interest. Do bring along good-quality, sturdy walking shoes or hiking boots. We will also let you in on one of the best secrets our mothers taught us: Wool is the secret to being warm and comfortable in our North Atlantic climate. Wool socks, as opposed to cotton or acrylic, are really the best choice for enjoy-ing Fogo Island's wilderness.
