Sample 3-Night Itinerary

DAY 1 - Friday, April 19, 2019 – Good Friday

AFTERNOON

Arrive on Fogo Island and allow the Island to reveal itself on the 30-minute drive through outport communities as you make your way off to your spring refuge, Fogo Island Inn. Take time to make time and revel in the natural beauty found around every bend.

Check into Fogo Island Inn, a traditional yet contemporary masterpiece of modern architecture and design. The Inn has recently been named Top Resort Hotel, Canada for the second consecutive year in the Travel + Leisure World's Best Awards 2018, and the Top Hotel in Canada in the Condé Nast Traveller Readers' Choice Awards 2018.

LATE AFTERNOON

Even though it will be difficult to leave the comforts of your room, do tear yourself away to join us for special spring beverages in the Lounge sourced from seasonal ingredients fresh and foraged.

SUPPER

Good Friday Seafood Supper is served in our Dining Room. Enjoy the abundant offerings brought to our shores by the Labrador Current while the waves of the Atlantic crash just beyond your table setting.

EVENING

Join local musicians in the Lounge for songs and stories of courage, victory, and loss.

DAY 2 – Saturday, April 20, 2019

DAYBREAK

Wake up and meet the day with a special surprise just outside your door: a Daybreak Tray featuring tea or coffee and fresh pastries.

7 – 10 AM

Breakfast is served in the Dining Room at your leisure.

10AM

Meet your Community Host in the Lobby for your Island Orientation. Be prepared for fresh perspectives and insights, stories and laughter during your half-day outing discovering this “salty Narnia” by the people of the place, whose sense of self comes from deep historical ties to landscape and seascape.

12 – 2 PM

Walk past the solitary, off-the-grid Long Studio designed by architect Todd Saunders, which hovers on a series of stilts that lifts the structure above the ground to frame a spectacular view of the North Atlantic Ocean. Fogo Island brings out the walker in us, so allow time to carry on past the Long Studio along the coast to pay homage to the Great Auk—a flightless bird that once lived on the nearby Funk Islands.
