The itinerary may include family- sized suites for up to four or five people. It is organized around you and no generation is left out. With no waterslides or costumed cartoon characters in sight, your time at the Fogo

Sample 3-Night Itinerary

DAY 1

ARRIVAL

Arrive on Fogo Island and allow the Island start to reveal itself on the 30-minute drive through outport communities as you make your way off to your refuge, Fogo Island Inn. Take time for exploration. Revel in the natural beauty found around every bend.

Check into Fogo Island Inn, a traditional yet contemporary masterpiece of modern architecture and design which will serve as home-base for the duration of your outport adventure. The Inn was named as Travel & Leisure's Best Resort Hotel in Canada, 2017 - among the country's best hotels from coast to coast.

SUPPER

Supper served in the Dining Room. Enjoy the abundant offerings (and kid-friendly options) brought to our shores by the Labrador Current while you watch the waves of the wild North Atlantic Ocean crash just beyond your table setting.

EVENING Request a favourite film and enjoy a special

screening in the Inn's 37-seat Cinema stocked with tasty Newfoundland snacks.

DAY 2

DAYBREAK Greet the sun as she rises and find a

handmade wooden Daybreak Tray outside your door filled with juice, coffee or tea, and

fresh pastries. Linger.

MORNING Breakfast served in the Dining Room at your

amble along to Joe Batt's Point foraging for shoreline herbs and wild foods along the way, past the Fogo Island Arts' Long Studio, and culminating in a visit to the Great Auk, the large bronze sculpture created by artist Todd McGrain as part of his Lost Birds

Project.

SUPPER Return to the Inn and enjoy supper served in

the Dining Room, where the provenance of every menu is inspired by the seasonal taste of the outport terroir. Everything coming out of the kitchen is intended to

feed more than your hunger.

EVENING

After supper, adults can unwind in the rooftop sauna and hotubs with infinite views of the starry skies, while kids can head to the Lobby for some stargazing through the Inn's telescope. (Childcare services are available for an additional fee).

DAY 3

DAYBREAK

Meet another morning with your Daybreak Tray. Ease into the day gradually.

MORNING

Breakfast at your leisure in the Dining Room.

10:00AM

(Optional, for an additional fee) Board the Ketanja in the company of Captain Ane for a marine excursion to neighbouring Little Fogo Islands—an archipelago of tiny resettled islands still dotted with traditional cabins, hiking trails, and pristine, untouched wildlife to observe. Keep an eye out for seabirds like dovekies, murrs, and puffins, and cresting whales diving amongst the waves.

(Optional, for an additional fee) All About Boats: Meet with a Community Host who will show you how to tie nautical knots and explain the tradition of splitting and salting cod, and if you are feeling adventurous, teach you how to row a Fogo Island punt.

DINNER (LUNCH)

Lunch is a traditional island boil-up: a meal served outdoors by a Community Host over an open fire where one can truly soak in the surroundings and enjoy a local Fogo Island custom which might include staples like salt fish, cod cakes, lassy bread, blackberry cake, jam tart, and strong tea.

AFTERNOON Stop by Growlers for a cone of localy-made

ice-cream in favourite flavours like Jam-Jam

and Partridgeberry.

2:30PM Tour of the Fogo Island Shop—the restored

Society of United Fisherman (SUF) Hall where woodworkers build the Inn's

distinctive furniture pieces.

Visit the Winds and Waves Artisan's Guild featuring quilts and handmade items produced by local craftspeople from Fogo Island and the surrounding communities.

SUPPER Supper served in the Dining Room.

EVENING Parents can retire to the Lounge with a

cocktail flavoured from the island's varieties of edible berries, shoreline ingredients, and traditional preserving techniques, while kids munch on delicious bar-snacks. Alternately, delve into the collection of Newfoundlandia in the second-floor heritage Library, or view the exhibition currently on display at the

Fogo Island Gallery.

DAY 4

DAYBREAK Enjoy your Daybreak Tray from the comfort

of your room.

MORNING Fortify yourself with a farewell breakfast in

the Dining Room in preparation for the

journey home.
