Fogo Island, NL., Wednesday, December 20, 2017—This February, passion-inspired lovers of nature and adventure are invited to the very edge of the North Atlantic to experience the unspoiled beauty and magic of winter—where, quite possibly, love is in the air. On the weekend of February 16, 2018, noted ornithologist Dr. Bill Montevecchi returns to Fogo Island Inn to lead the annual **LOVE (the) BIRDS** retreat. Guests joining the two-night **LOVE (the) Birds** weekend (beginning Friday, February 16 and departing Sunday, February 18) will retreat to Fogo Island Inn with Dr. Bill Montevecchi, who will lead birding enthusiasts in the pursuit of Newfoundland birds. Guests will keep their eyes peeled for sightings of Dovekies, Murres, Mergansers, Snow Buntings, Eiders, Ptarmigans, and all manner of migratory seabirds that spend their winter in the vicinity of Fogo Island. The **LOVE (the) BIRDS** weekend itinerary—timed for Valentine's Day week—is ideal for both lovebirds or bird-lovers, and includes all meals, a wine-and-cheese pairing, birding lectures, a guided bird-watching outing, and numerous outdoor activities including skating, snow-shoeing, and caribou tracking (weather permitting, of course).

The **Winter Lover's Road Trip** runs throughout the entire month of February 2018. Fogo Island Inn partners with CapeRace—the upbeat, boutique, Newfoundland travel company—to bring guests this epic winter experience. CapeRace, known for self-guided experiential travel experiences on North America's easternmost island, will provide a rental car upon arrival at St. John's International Airport and accommodations in St. John's Outer Battery Village area, near the slopes of iconic Signal Hill where Jellybean houses stand on every corner. Day Two takes adventurers to Heart's Delight, a stunning coastal community (population: 674) on the shores of Trinity Bay, where guests spend the night in a charming, rustic outport bungalow surrounded by incredible vistas and rocky coastlines that are perfect for exploring. The next day, the journey continues northward to Farewell to catch the 1-hour ferry ride to Fogo Island. Upon arrival, travelers are extended a warm welcome at Fogo Island Inn, where they'll enjoy two days of fine dining, exhilarating winter activities, and leisure comforts.

ACCESS TO FOGO ISLAND, NEWFOUNDLAND, CANADA

Gander, Newfoundland is the international gateway to Fogo Island. Commercial flights from Toronto with connections in St. John's or Halifax can bring travelers to Gander in just over four hours. The Inn offers a land- and-ferry pick-up and return service to Gander. Travel from Gander to Fogo Island takes two hours by car or around 30 minutes by charter plane or helicopter.
