## Sample 3-Night Itinerary

### DAY 1

#### AFTERNOON

Arrive on Fogo Island and allow the Island start to reveal itself on the 30-minute drive through outpost communities as you make your way off to your family refuge, [Fogo Island Inn](#). Take time for exploration. Revel in the natural beauty found around every bend.

Check into [Fogo Island Inn](#), a traditional yet contemporary masterpiece of modern architecture and design. The Inn was named as Travel & Leisure's Best Resort Hotel in Canada, 2017 and 2018 - among the country's best hotels from coast to coast.

#### LATE AFTERNOON

Spend a few moments exploring your room. When you're ready, find your way down to the Lounge.

#### SUPPER

Dine on fresh flavours and the bounty of land and sea as you watch waves crash just beyond your table setting in the Dining Room.

#### LATE EVENING

Request a favourite film and enjoy a special screening in the Inn's 37-seat Cinema stocked with tasty Newfoundland snacks before tucking in for the night to the soothing rumble of the tumultuous North Atlantic.

## **DAY 2**

### **DAYBREAK**

Find a morning surprise as the sun rises: a handmade wooden Daybreak Tray outside your door filled with coffee or tea, juice and fresh pastries. Linger.

### **MORNING**

Breakfast is served in the Dining Room at your leisure.

### **10:00AM**

Suit up in winter gear and get ready to embark on your family cabin adventure. Snowshoe or snowmobile to the Island's center and arrive at your inland winter playground. Spend the day at the cabin partaking in traditional food and outdoor fun, including exhilarating activities such as: tobogganing down hills of blindingly white snow, skating on ponds long-frozen over, or take another carefree jaunt on a snowmobile.

### **DINNER (LUNCH)**

Lunch is a traditional island boil-up—a meal cooked over an open fire with the pristine wilderness as backdrop.

### **AFTERNOON**

Exhausted and elated, and when the time is right for you, make your way back to Fogo Island Inn to warm up by the woodstove with a toasty beverage or cozy up with a book in the heritage Library. The shuffling of exhausted boots traipsing back through the doors of Fogo Island Inn will be the perfect final notes of the soundtrack of a fun-filled day characterized by the rhythmic exchange of raucous laughter and the stillest silences of the landscape.

**SUPPER**

Feast on a meal prepared by Executive Chef Jonathan Gushue and his kitchen team. Each menu is inspired by the seasonal tastes of the outport terroir. Everything coming out of the kitchen is intended to feed more than your hunger.

**EVENING**

Retreat to the rooftop for a soak in the hot tubs, or stargaze as the dark skies fill, counting the stars and tracing the constellations above.

**DAY 3**

**DAYBREAK**

Meet another day with your Daybreak Tray. Ease into the morning gradually.

**MORNING**

Breakfast at your leisure in the Dining Room.

**AFTERNOON**

With a full belly, grab your mitts and hats warmed by the stove and step back outside into the graces of the pristine Fogo Island winter. Pair up with a Community Host for an Island Orientation that will delight you in the history and culture of this singular place, or engage in some more freewheeling winter rollicking amongst the snow and ice. With assistance or all by yourself, bore a few holes in the ice and catch pond trout still swimming deep below the frozen surface, or choose to forge new trails through the snow on foot or snowshoe.

**LATE  
AFTERNOON**

Take in the comforts of the Inn itself: rooftop saunas and outdoor hot tubs, the Fogo Island

Gallery, and the Cinema are all yours to explore.

**SUPPER**

Supper served in the Dining Room at your leisure.

**EVENING**

With the little ones tucked-in, parents can convene to the Lounge to enjoy cocktails flavoured from the Island's 16 varieties of edible berries, or sip from our extensive wine collection influenced by the best of Canadian wines and Fogo Island's traditional trading partners (Italy, France, Spain and Portugal). Unwind.

**DAY 4**

**DAYBREAK**

Enjoy your departing Daybreak Tray from the comfort of your room.

**MORNING**

Fortify yourself with a farewell breakfast in the Dining Room.

End your Fogo Island retreat and prepare for the journey homewards with a drive to the ferry terminal, or travel a shorter distance to Fogo Island's charter landing strip, daydreaming of future adventures.
