## Fogo Island Winter Cabin Outing

## Available Winter Season and Pack Ice Season (February 22 through to March 31, 2019)



There is a place where snow and ice are heroes of adventure, fun, relaxation, and time well spent with family and friends. Colder months coupled with a blanket of chilled precipitation create an inland playground serviced by trails both well-travelled and waiting to be forged. Traditional Newfoundland cabins are the primary setting for this wild and wonderful winter amusement on Fogo Island.

The **Winter Cabin Outing** itinerary at Fogo Island Inn includes all meals, an Island orientation with a Community Host, a cabin outing and a range of outdoor activities and excursions. ## Sample 3-Night Itinerary

DAY 1

AFTERNOON	Arrive on Fogo Island and allow the Island to reveal itself on the 30-minute drive through outport communities as you make your way off to your refuge, Fogo Island Inn. Take time for exploration. Revel in the natural beauty found around every bend.
	Check into Fogo Island Inn, a traditional yet contemporary masterpiece of modern architecture and design. The Inn was named as Travel & Leisure's Best Resort Hotel in Canada in 2017 and 2018, as well as the Top Hotel in Canada in the Condé Nast Traveler Readers' Choice Awards 2017-2018.
LATE AFTERNOON	Spend a few moments relaxing in your room. When you're ready, find your way down to the Lounge.
EVENING	Dine on the fresh flavours and the bounty of land and sea as supper is prepared by Fogo Island Inn's Executive Chef Jonathan Gushue and his culinary team in the Inn's Dining Room.
LATE EVENING	Catch a film in the Inn's Cinema before tucking in for the night to the rumble of the tumultuous North Atlantic just beyond your window.

DAY 2	
DAYBREAK	Greet the sun as she rises and find a handmade wooden Daybreak Tray outside your door filled with coffee, tea and fresh pastries. Linger.
MORNING	Breakfast is served in the Dining Room at your leisure.
10:00AM	Suit up in winter gear and get ready to embark on your cabin adventure. Snowshoe or snowmobile to the Island's center and arrive at your inland winter escape. Spend the day at the cabin partaking in traditional food and outdoor fun, including your choice of exhilarating activities: toboggan down hills of blindingly white snow, skate on ponds long frozen over, or jump back on the snowmobile for another carefree jaunt. As darkness of early evening falls help build a bonfire to illuminate your terrestrial surroundings, and gaze up to find a sky about to be filled with celestial beauties you'd never dream to find under the clouds of any city.
EVENING	Exhausted and elated, and when the time is right for you, make your way back to Fogo Island Inn to feast on a meal prepared by Executive Chef Jonathan Gushue and the Inn's culinary team.
	The shuffling of exhausted boots traipsing back through the doors of Fogo Island Inn will be the perfect final notes of the soundtrack of a day characterized by the rhythmic exchange of raucous laughter and the stillest silences.

LATE EVENING	Before retiring to your room, it is the chance to soak your tired but contented muscles in our roof top saunas and hot tubs as you gaze up at the infinite starry sky.
DAY 3	
DAYBREAK	Meet another day with your Daybreak Tray. Ease into the morning gradually.
MORNING	Breakfast at your leisure in the Dining Room.
AFTERNOON	With a full belly, grab your mitts and hats warmed by the stove and step back outside into the graces of the pristine Fogo Island winter. Pair up with a Community Host for an Island Orientation that will immerse you in the history and culture of this singular place, or engage in some more freewheeling winter rollicking among the snow and ice. With assistance or all by yourself, bore a few holes in the ice and catch pond trout still swimming deep below the frozen surface, or choose to forge new trails through the snow on foot or snowshoe.
LATE AFTERNOON	Take in the comforts of the Inn itself: rooftop saunas and outdoor hot tubs, the Fogo Island Gallery, and the Cinema are all yours to revel in.
EVENING	Dine in our Inn's award-winning Dining Room. Here is where you will enjoy a contemporary take on Newfoundland cuisine, while waves crash on the shoreline just beyond your table setting.

	Then, convene to the Lounge to enjoy cocktails flavoured from the island's many varieties of edible berries, or sip from our extensive wine collection influenced by the best of Canadian wines and Fogo Island's traditional trading partners (Italy, France, Spain and Portugal).
DAY 4	
DAYBREAK	Enjoy your departing Daybreak Tray from the comfort of your room. Linger.
MORNING	Fortify yourself with a farewell breakfast in the Dining Room.
